

## MEDIUM POWER RATE - PRIMARY

## CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Service under this rate schedule is available for all commercial or industrial purposes where the customer agrees to pay for not less than 25 kW or more of demand and where the customer's actual demand is less than 500 kW during the preceding 12 month period. Customer locations that have not received service during the preceding six month period shall not be permitted to take service under this rate schedule if the Company, in its sole discretion, determines that the anticipated demand of the location shall be equal to or greater than 500 kW. Customers that were members of this class on or before February 20, 2000 may continue to take service under this class if their demand exceeds 500 kW so long as their actual demand does not exceed their highest demand for the preceding 36 month period by more than 5%. Service under this rate schedule shall be provided at primary voltage and the customer shall be required to own and maintain such transformers and other related facilities as may be required to transform the available primary voltage to the voltage required by the customer. Customers taking service under this rate schedule are responsible for paying both Distribution Service and Stranded Cost.


## DETERMINATION OF DEMAND

The demand will be determined by a suitable meter or meters installed and maintained by the Company.  
the Company.

The demand used for billing (demand) will be the greatest of the following:

1. The average load during the fifteen (15) minute period of maximum use in the current month.
2. Fifty percent (50%) of the highest billing demand established during the preceding eleven (11) months.
