

STANDBY 30 - PRIMARY (CONTINUED)

DETERMINATION OF DEMAND

The demand will be determined by a suitable meter or meters installed and maintained by the Company.

The demand used for billing (demand) will be the greatest of the following:

- 1. The average load during the fifteen (15) minute period of maximum use in the current month.
- 2. One hundred percent (100%) of the highest actual demand established during the preceding eleven (11) months for Distribution and (50%) of Billed Demand for Stranded Cost and Transmission.

MINIMUM CHARGE

\$917.58 per month for customer charge, plus

Either)	\$72.75 per month during the peak season for a minimum of 25 kW billing demand.	R
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Or)	\$72.75 per month during the non-peak season for a minimum of 25 kW billing demand.	R
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Peak Season will be from November through February. Off-peak season will be the remaining months.

TRANSMISSION SERVICE

The Transmission Rate shown in this rate schedule is for information purposes only. CONSERVATION & SOLAR ASSESSMENT CHARGE

The conservation and solar assessment charges in accordance with Subsection 12-J of the Terms and Conditions are included in the per kWh charges of the distribution service rates above.

LATE PAYMENT CHARGE

A late payment charge in accordance with Section 4-F of the Terms and Conditions shall apply to customers taking service under this rate.
