

RESIDENTIAL LOW INCOME SERVICE RATE  
101% TO 230% OF THE FEDERAL POVERTY GUIDELINES

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Service under this rate is available for lighting and other domestic purposes in individual residences and individual apartments. It is not applicable where the use of electricity is for commercial purposes. Customers taking service under this rate schedule are responsible for paying both Distribution Service and Stranded Cost. All residential customers who satisfy the following criteria shall be eligible for this rate

1. The customer is certified to be above 101% and at or below 230% of the federal poverty guidelines and eligible for HEAP benefits.
2. The customer completes and signs a Low Income Rate Program application form and agrees to provide financial information that proves the customer is HEAP eligible and their household income is above 101%, and at or below 230% of the federal poverty guidelines to their local C.A.P. office, or, if applicable, through a local tribal organization that is approved by the Federal Government to administer LIHEAP in the State of Maine.
3. Customers receiving substantial housing subsidies as defined by HEAP rules shall not be eligible for service under this rate.
4. Customers determined eligible for service under this rate shall remain eligible for the duration of the program year.


TRANSMISSION SERVICE
